Suburban and Lions have called many places home over the years

Fremantle Esplanade 1922

First game 20 May 1922 vs Fremantle

Claremont Showgrounds 1922 - 1937

Esplanade Kiosk, Perth 1938 - 1954

Hired as changerooms for seven shillings and a sixpence

Verdun Street, Hollywood 1955 - 1959

Current site of C Block of Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital

Rosalie Park, Subiaco 1955 - 1959

No clubrooms or changing facilities

Shenton Park Lake (Jualbup Lake) 1960 - 2008

Subiaco HC's lakeside ground with no clubrooms or amenities

Highview Park, Hollywood since 1960

Known as "Tregonning Field" by the hockey community

Nedlands Foreshore 1970's - 1990's

Many lost balls in the river

Hollywood High School 1980's

Pat Goodridge Reserve 1990's

Lemnos Field, Shenton Park since 2003

Joint turf between Suburban, Riverside, YMCC and Wolves.

*Now owned by Suburban Lions, YMCC and Wolves
Known as Shenton Turf*

Melvista Park since 2009

Home ground for Riverside Lions
